Matters arising	 Frank submitted a nomination to the Shropshire Star that Judy receive an award as an environmental champion. Formal thanks from the group to Frank, Maralyn and Tony for staffing a Market Square stall at short notice. It went well. Many more signatures for the bee petition 	
Finance	 Co-op Bank update Signatures have now been organised. 2 out of 3: Judy, Tony and Sue. Mike has sorted out the Paypal password which Tony now has. There were no transactions in March. In April: total £7.10 donation and £22 subs. Total balance: £2,797.25. 22 members still owe subs for this year. SOGS, who have given us very generous donations in past years, decided to give £100 to Oswestry FoE this year to help them get started. 	
Local Campaigns/ projects	Planning. Frank wrote a letter to the Star to make people aware of the planning situation and to encourage them to object where detrimental proposals are put forward. It was printed, but heavily edited. CPRE & SWLT meeting about planning. Frank and Philip went. Audience of about 150. Disappointing presentations apparently from the developer viewpoint. Frank agreed to find out what is happening re SC's lobbying of Dept of Comms & Local Govt. (a) to be allowed to refuse planning applications and (b) the calculation of the 5-yr land supply. Recycling Flower Show. The organisers are introducing an "Our Future" marquee which will include the environment. SOGS are intending to speak to them about this. Frank will speak to Maggie Fennell about it. PG skips appear to be recycling the Flower Show waste as effectively as possible. This year, they will put up notices at the Show explaining what happens to the waste Tony attended the Cae Post lecture which was by John Vidal about climate change and its effect on food. GG. Mike has not finished his draft stickers. Judy, Sue and he are meeting this Wed and will discuss it. Traffic Frank and Barbara had a positive meeting with Andrew Bannerman and will be contacting/meeting with a number of other people soon. NB Marches Local Enterprise Board applied for £105m for Shropshire roads and seem to have allocated £27m to Shrewsbury. Methane drill site near Ellesmere Dart are submitting an application to SC to proceed with drilling without an environmental assessment on an exploration site just outside Ellesmere. The meeting about this that Tony went to was organised by a Green Party councillor and Oswestry FoE. He agreed to send a support letter saying we believed there should be an environmental assessment and that it would be best to refuse permission entirely.
